Selecting a MTW fastener

Selecting the appropriate fastener for your metal to wood panel applications is important. There is one main thing holding down your metal panels and that is your fastener. Not all fasteners are created the same. DMI offers multiple choices that differ in strength, size, price and corrosion resistance.

When specifying a fastener, important factors to consider: What is the substrate? What is the attachment material? What is the environment? What does the budget allow? Ask questions such as: Is this installation close to water or corrosive chemicals such as chlorine? Will this be installed into pressure treated lumber? Will the customer be installing a steel or aluminum panel? What does the customer expect for longevity or corrosion free performance? What is the time frame in which we need to deliver the material? These are all important questions to ask to determine which panel fastener to offer.

Quick guidelines:

Use full 304 stainless steel fasteners or DMI Bi-Metal fasteners for applications within 3000 Inft of saltwater or other corrosives. Applications into pressure treated lumber. Installation of aluminum or copper panels. For applications in coastal cities consider premium fasteners such as S.C.A.M.P. stainless steel cap or WoodZAC that have warranties that match or exceed your panel warranty.

Installing a MTW fastener

Equally important to selecting the correct fastener is the use of proper installation procedures. The selection of the proper tool is important. Lightweight cordless impact drivers have become popular in construction however they are not suitable for installation of metal roofing fasteners as it may overdrive fasteners, crack protective finishes on fasteners, washer guards and or panels. For metal to wood applications an electric screw driver with a maximum of 2,500 rpm and a depth sensing torque relief device is suggested. When installing 304, 305 and 316 stainless steel fasteners it is suggested to slow the speeds to 1000 rpm. Torque fasteners to approximately 70% of their torsional strength found on the product data sheet.

Drive fasteners perpendicular to the panel surface. Avoid over driving or under-driving fasteners taking care to properly seat washers against the panel surface. If you are unsure of how to install our fasteners please call our office at 855-800-8878 for a printed guide.
